High tournaments of Cadets and Juniors!

Cadets have only been pitching at 20 feet for the last few years. The bar keeps getting raised for the top in history as

each year passes. The top Cadet tournament was pitched this year by Jackson VanCleave with 25.34% in Jackson on February 17,2024. (For the top tournament lists, only the highest pitched by each player is listed). Bryce VanCleave is #2 on the list, with his tournament on July 29, 2022, where he pitched 17.86% in Kalamazoo. Bryce has moved into the Junior Class since that tournament. Bryce and Jackson are related to Joe Hetrick, who may be related to Alaska's 1987 champion Larry Hetrick. Blake Morehead is #3 with 13.89% on

April 29, 2023 in Jackson. Daven Lockwood is #4 on the list. Daven was one of the first Cadet pitchers, and his 11.58% on April 30, 2016 in Mt. Morris was his highest. Fifth is Tristan Davidson, with a March 25, 2023 tournament in Jackson where 6.52% was pitched.

When listing the top juniors, we need to go back to the late 1970s and early 1980s for the top Junior



tournaments. First we go all the way back to 1981 (June 21), where Dave Simmet pitched 77.8% in Lansing. Dave and his brother Pat were top juniors back in the late 1970s and early 1980s. Other top pitchers added to the competition in the 1980s, as Dean LeClair pitched 76.8% on September 2, 1985 in Dimondale. Dean had a couple of Junior State Championships and has been a Men's State Champion. Third on the Juniors list is Tom Williams, who pitched 75.7% in Dimondale on September 5, 1982. He's won a just a few Men's State Championships. Kevin Smith is #4 on this list, and is another pitcher who added to the stiff competition among juniors in this time period. His high was 74% in Jackson on June 14, 1981. He has been a long time competitor in Michigan. The fifth junior on this top tournament list is from the 2000s, as Joshua Carr had a good run during this period. His high was 72.5% in Jackson on March 4, 2006. He has drifted away from pitching in recent years.

In the next installment, we will list the top 40 foot men, where there will be more surprising names. A later list will list the top women's and Elder's tournaments.
