Paul joined the then Wolverine State Horseshoe Pitching Association in 1995, pitching his first tournament on March 11, 1995 indoors at Jackson. He was an integral part of the fledgling Brighton club from its beginning. He pitched his first 50% tournament on August 23, 2003 with 53.9%, and won the Class B Men's championship at the state tournament the next weekend.

Paul became a formidable force in Men's pitching, as he finished in the top 4 at the state tournament nine times from 2009 through 2019, with 5 finishes in 3rd place. His first 60% tournament was at Brighton on July 4, 2009, winning Class B with 64.3%. Paul also finished second in the Senior Men's championship at Hamburg, New York in 2014.

Paul served as 2nd Vice president in 2013 and 2014, and as President of the MHPA from 2015 through 2018. He has been tournament director for Brighton from 2010 through the closing of the club in 2022. He has continued running winter tournaments in Jackson since the Brighton club closed. He has always been a gentleman on the courts, and we are proud to induct him into the MHPA Hall of Fame.
