## Constitution, By-Laws Changes

• **Entry fees for Indoor and Outdoor district tournaments shall be \$20.00 (minimum).**

**\$20** This adjustment in the tournament entry fee will allow for an increased payout for our participants and by reducing the number of places paid out, that will also increase the payouts. There had not been an increase in the tournament entry fee in many years. There was also a change in the fees that were being paid to the Jackson Horseshoe Club for utilities/use of the facility. The fee was previously \$8/player and is being reduced to \$6/player. This will allow some additional money to be paid out.

• **MHPA tournament participants will be allowed to place their beverages (non-alcoholic/alcoholic) behind the backboard on the courts.** Beverages must be in a covered container and not be glass.


# TEAM WORLD

**The 40th Team World Tournament will be held May 15, 16, and 17, 2026, Beloit, WI.**

The MHPA is in the process of forming teams for this event. Team World is a 3-day event.

The entry fee is \$200 per team. Teams are assessed a scorekeeper fee of \$1 per player, per game, when teams arrive to check in. Teams do have the option of including a 5th player on their team with no additional entry cost to the team. This 5th player can be from any division (Men, Women, Elders, and/or Junior Boys/Girls) except Cadets, provided the combination does not exceed the maximum limit of (3) short distance pitchers. The event is limited to 24 teams. Teams with the lowest combined entering ringer percentage from a U.S. state with multiple teams entered may be denied entry if more than 24 teams or an odd number of teams enter.

J.D. Drake from Michigan received the Team World Earl Paulson Award in 2025. J.D. was the first to be recognized for his accomplishments at Team World as an elders' division pitcher. J.D.'s Michigan teams placed 5th or higher in 9 of the 12 years he has pitched, including winning Team World in 2017 and having the highest average in the tournament

**What the rules say...**

It is legal for a contestant to carry and use a blunt-ended hook or horseshoe pick-up device, but it cannot exceed thirty-six inches (36") in total length. Any hook cannot protrude more than two inches (2") from the main shaft. Care should be taken in using the hook so as not to endanger the opponent or other contestants. Contestants are also encouraged to carry measuring tools as well as a file and towel to keep their shoes burr-free and shoes/hands clean and dry.

**Note:** All measurement tools manufactured for sale must be pre-approved by the NHPA Council. (For sanctioned tournaments)

## 15 Minutes to go, but 30 Seconds to pitch!

This month I'd like to share some information regarding the use of judges at all NHPA sanctioned events, including world and state tournaments. Everybody knows that it is up to the players to determine the score at each end of your court. If you are unable to do this, then you both should agree to call for a judge. I'm sure most of you know this, but I want to reiterate that once you call for that judge, both players must step away and let that judge determine the score, and the judge's decision is FINAL. The NHPA strives to have the best trained.

There was a judging incident that happened at the world tournament in Sandy. It involved the 30 second rule to release both shoes. The situation was not handled well and

caused a lot of hard feelings. We all know that the 30 second rule is somewhat subjective and unclear in certain ways. Long story short, the NHPA has adopted a new policy to deal with this situation at the world tournament.

All judges will be instructed that they are not allowed to take any action regarding the 30 second rule with any player without getting the shift director or an NHPA officer involved first. I believe this new policy is self-explanatory, but if anybody has any questions regarding this policy, feel free to contact me.



## Go ahead and pitch, don't wait!

Go ahead and pitch, especially in doubles play. Waiting for others up or down the line may be distracting for those waiting to pitch. I am always asked: "What are they waiting for?" It takes time from the game, breaks up the rhythm and sometimes is very annoying. Concentrate and focus on your target which is the stake. Lock out all distractions and you will become a better pitcher. **But, keep alert. Getting hit by a horseshoe will hurt.**

### Sanctioning a New Designed Horseshoe

Any shoe that is altered from its original design would not be legal in any NHPA sanctioned event. Grinding off the ringer breaker would make the shoe altered and therefore illegal.

The cost to have a new horseshoe sanctioned by the NHPA is \$300 with a \$100 yearly fee every year there after as long as the shoe is being manufactured. A prototype must be sent to the NHPA Sec./Treas. to start this sanctioning. There have been a couple of pitchers that invented their own horseshoe, got it sanctioned and did so only for their own use. A rather expensive horseshoe.

With over 50 different shoes currently sanctioned plus many more that are no longer made but still out there for sale and still sanctioned, one would think that there by now was a shoe made that covers any ones needs.

### NHPF Grant Qualification

There is no requirement for a club applying for a grant to be registered with the state or feds as a non-profit. Ideally, the club would be part of an NHPA charter but that also is not a requirement. One thing to keep in mind is that the NHPF cannot grant funds to an individual or a club if the money is to be used to make permanent improvements on privately owned property.

NHPF grant checks must be issued to organized clubs, associations, city, county, state or federal entities where the funds will be used to enhance horseshoe pitching opportunities open to the general public.

NHPA clubs with courts on public owned land qualify because they are open to the general public. If a club or charter is leasing a privately owned site, indoor or out, the NHPF could provide funds for portable courts to be used at those sites because ownership of the courts stays with the club or charter and no funds were used to improve the privately owned site.
